Catalyst Problem

I'm having a problem installing catalyst Discourse on my Profile. I am using an Apple/// with a Comrex CR-II (same as Brother HR-15) or an Epson RX-80 printer, going through a UPIC card with the standard cable that came with the card. When I try to print something to .spool, it tells me my printer power is off. I am using the .printer driver that works with my printer; the standard configuration block reads 00 00 00 00 5A. I tried changing this to E8 C8 00 00 5A at Quark's suggestion, and the message "out of paper" came back instead. I tried E8 48 00 00 5A, and it was back to "printer power off." Has anyone had similar problems getting Discourse to work? Is there some way I can alter the configuration block to have the spooler not receive imaginary error messages ? Thanks!
