I sent information to an IBM PC at 1200 baud with Terminus. My procedure was as follows. First to Strip the Word Juggler Control Characters Load the file, Save the file with an Asterisk (to a new file name), Load new file with Asterick, Save without the Asterisk. The file is now ready for transmission.

This procedure "strips" most of the control characters from the file. The transmission cab be done with LF OFF or LF ON. With LF ON it will put "hard" carriage returns on the end of every line. For indexes or pages with alot of formating, you may want to leave the LF ON, but for normal text, LF OFF probably is better. My experience was with an IBM using Wordstar. "Soft" carriage returns were to be stripped out using a short basic utility. If you find yourself in this position of needing the utility, give me a call or leave me a message on Draco and I tell you how to get the Basic utility to do this.
